White Wine

- Pinot Grigio delle Venezie IGT** £25.00
Veneto, Italy
Delicious Fiano, packed with tropical fruit, the bouquet a vibrant blend of refreshing lemon and spicy cedar.
- Verdicchio Classico Titulus** £29.50
Marche, Italy
A fine and intense bouquet with fruity and floral aromas. The palate has pleasant, vibrant and fresh notes and a typically almond aftertaste.
- Fiano IGT Terre Siciliane, Molino a Vento** £29.00
Sicily, Italy
Vibrant and aromatic with notes of citrus fruits, lychee, pineapple and peach complemented by hints of minerals, herbs and mint. Full and dry, smooth and supple with a long, minty finish.
- Vermentino di Sardegna, Villa Solais, Santadi** £31.00
Sardinia, Italy
This golden coloured, dry wine is herbal and aromatic, displaying light almond flavours and a fresh, well balanced finish.
- Pecorino, Fazi Battaglia** £33.00
Abruzzo, Italy
Fresh aromas of lemons with flavours of pear skins and a backbone of mineral acidity.
- Gavi di Gavi, La Minaia, Nicola Bergaglio** £36.00
Piemonte, Italy
A light, fresh, mineral and citrus bouquet. The palate is crisp and dry, with a hint of ripe pears.

Spain and Portugal

- Alvarinho Pouco Comum, Quinta da Lixa** £28.50
Vinho Verde, Portugal
Fantastic display of peach, lemon and grapefruit, with floral tones and a generous, full texture.
- Rioja Blanco Heredad de Tejada, Bodega Classica, Vintae** £26.50
Rioja, Spain
A mouthful of dates, bananas and nuts from this alluring white Rioja, which is fresh yet complex.

New Zealand

- Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc, Glazebrook** £32.00
Marlborough, New Zealand
Crisp and zesty with moments of citrus and grapefruit, crunchy green apple, juicy peach and passionfruit with fresh garden herbs

France

- Pouilly-Fumé, Château Favray** £44.00
Loire, France
Clean, crisp Sauvignon Blanc from the grape's Loire home, this is scented with fresh grass, limestone and citrus and both stone and fruit follow the wine onto the tongue.
- Chablis 1er Cru Les Lys, Bernard Defaix** £60.00
Burgundy, France
Premium Premier Cru Chablis, citrusy and refreshing, with a shard of stone and a faint hint of spice.

Rosé Wine

- Pinot Grigio Blush IGT** £25.00
Veneto, Italy
Freshly crushed cranberries and mineral elements. The palate is light, dry and crisp, with a delicious balance between zingy citrus and fruity red berry flavours.
- Sangiovese Rosato Rubicone IGT, Sospiro** £25.00
Emilia Romagna, Italy
Rose petal, pomegranate, blood orange.

Red Wine

- Montepulciano d'Abruzzo, 20 Borgo Sena** £24.00
Abruzzo, Italy
Classic, plum-filled Montepulciano d'Abruzzo, pleasantly scented with violets, peonies and more plums.
- Nero d'Avola, Molino a Vento, IGT Terre Siciliane** £26.00
Sicily, Italy
Pleasant aromas of red cherry and raspberry lead this wine, and are mirrored perfectly on the palate, alongside a mineral acidity.
- Biferno Rosso Riserva DOC, Palladino** £25.00
Molise, Italy
The bouquet is complex and intense with hints of blackberry jam.
- Syrah, Molino a Vento, IGT Terre Siciliane** £27.00
Sicily, Italy
Aromas of crushed strawberries lead to supple tannins and fresh, rich acidity showing hints of chocolate.
- Negroamaro Primitivo IGT Salento, Baccanera** £27.00
Puglia, Italy
Complex, sophisticated red from southern Italy, full-bodied and intense, packed with blackberries, black cherries and plums and softly sweet on the finish.
- Chianti Classico DOCG, Castellani** £32.00
Tuscany, Italy
Quintessential Chianti, a blend of cherries and loamy earth, prettily perfumed by violets.
- Brusco dei Barbi, Fattoria dei Barbi** £33.00
Tuscany, Italy
Brilliant ruby red. It is full bodied with soft tannins and a rich long finish.
- Valpolicella Ripasso, Il Sospiro** £35.00
Veneto, Italy
Fruity, deep hints of wild berries and jam with structured, soft and warm finish.
- Vino Nobile di Montepulciano, Castellani** £36.50
Tuscany, Italy
In the mouth, the Vino Nobile is dry, lightly tannic which hints of vanilla and is beautifully balanced with a deep structure.
- Amarone Classico della Valpolicella** £75.00
Veneto, Italy
Deep almost opaque in colour with a pronounced nose of morello cherries interspersed with layers of oak and spice.

Spain and Portugal

- Douro Red, Quinta do Crasto** £27.00
Douro, Portugal
Dark and richly aromatic, with heady flavours of ripe red berries, violet and spice.
- Rioja Crianza Heredad de Tejada, Vintae** £29.50
Rioja, Spain
Aromas from the barrel (cream, cocoa and vanilla) with black as well as ripe fruits. Typical Tempranillo liquorice aromas at the end with spicy notes.

Argentina

- Don David Malbec, El Esteco** £26.00
Salta, Argentina
Well-balanced with soft tannins and notes of violets, plums, red fruits and a hint of chocolate.

France

- Bergerac Rouge Château Laulerie, Vignobles Dubard** £28.00
South West France
Soft, supple Merlot from south-west France, popping with red berries, trailed by flower petals and a hint of pepper.
- Château Bel-air, Puisseguin St Emilion** £40.00
Bordeaux, France
An elegant, soft, yet structured claret with ripe tannins and excellent fruit concentration.
